

MONOCHROMATIC ABSTRACT PAINTING

- 1) Choose ONE color and create TWO value scales on one page in your sketchbook. One value scale will be the pure color plus a range of 5 SHADES (color plus black). The other value scale will be the pure color plus a range of 5 TINTS (color plus white). (10 points)
- 2) Create an abstract monochromatic painting from your imagination –size 8X10”. Use pure color plus a range of shades and tints of that color. (10 points)
 - Use a variety of lines, shapes, patterns, texture, etc. to create interesting designs.
 - Build up the paint on the page. Layer paint and experiment with brush strokes and texture.
 - Use the entire page for your abstract design. There should be no untouched paper left over when you are done.
 - Focus on craftsmanship.
