Paper Airplane Activity

- 1. Take out a piece of paper. DO NOT write your name.
- 2. On that paper, write down 5 unique things about yourself.

For example: "I have a black belt in Karate" or "I play the cello."

Avoid obvious statements such as "I have brown hair" or "I like pizza."

Then answer the following questions:

- 1) What is your favorite activity?
- 2) Who/what inspires you and why?
- 3) What is a song on your playlist that describes you right now?
- 4) If you were a superhero or villain, what would your super power be?
- 3. Once you've written 5 unique things on the paper and answered the four questions, fold it into a paper airplane.
- 4. When I give the signal, let your airplane fly. Pick up the nearest airplane and let that fly again.
- 5. When I say stop, pick up the nearest airplane and unfold it.
- 6. Read the personal facts someone wrote.
- 7. Now it's time to figure out whom the plane belongs to.
- 8. Walk around and ask different classmates yes or no questions until you find the person whose paper airplane you have. ("Do you have a black belt in Karate?" If yes, ask the next fact.)
- 9. Once you find the owner of your airplane, KEEP THE AIRPLANE but follow the owner around as they search for the owner of their airplane.
- 10. Eventually, you should be in a chain of people following the leader who still hasn't found the owner of their airplane. Once everyone has found the owner of their airplane, the game is over!
