The Studio Performance Grade will count for 20% of your total class grade each quarter.

Your Studio Performance Grade will be assessed by:

1) Daily participation during class including:

- Staying on task and committing all your effort to your art-making.
- Keeping up with class/studio assignments and projects.
- Submitting assignments and projects on the due date.
- Participating in class discussions and critiques...etc.
- Demonstrating sincere effort in the process of making your art.
- Demonstrating sincere desire to improve in the making of your art.
- Demonstrating a great attitude with your teacher and your peers.
- Listening respectively to class instruction, lecture, discussions, and demonstrations.

2) Abiding by Classroom Rules and Policies including:

- Working in the designated Painting Classroom area until the bell rings.
- Cleaning up all your supplies, desk area, floor surrounding your desk, and around your computer.
- Working on your art until 5 minutes before the bell.
- No talking or texting on your cell phone in class.
- Appropriate and respectful classroom behavior.
- Abiding by the school and district technology use agreement.
- Using the computer for class projects only. (No personal use or Internet surfing.)

3) Attendance:

- Attending class and working all period on your art. Since there is only one homework assignment, your grade depends on what you complete during class time.
- Being on time: this means being in your seat when the bell rings awaiting instruction from your teacher.
- Unexcused absences will affect your studio grade negatively.
