
## Vinyl T-shirt Design

## Heat Transfer Vinyl Designs

Print on:

- T-shirt
- Sweatshirt
- Tote bag
- Baseball cap
- Pants/jeans
- Socks
- A scarf
- Fabric covered notebook

\*Make sure to prewash your item!!



1) Create your design in Photoshop or Illustrator.


- For 1 color designs create silhouettes of your design that are filled with 1 color and no stroke.
- For 2 or more color designs you must separate each color into a different layer and then create a separate document for each color design. Once printed you will layer each color on the T-shirt as a separate heat transfer.



\*Make sure to measure the printable area where your design will be on your T-shirt or other item to be printed on.

\*Create your design with the exact measurements.

\*Make sure to prewash your T-shirt or apparel.



- Any designs with text/ words/numbers must be flipped before you submit your design.
- Make a mirror image.
- When your design is ready to be transferred to your T-shirt it will flip back the "right" way.

- 2) Submit your file (1 color print) or multiple files (2 or more color print) to Mrs. Doerrer.
- Your designs must be on a blank white background and saved as a .jpeg.
- Or saved as a .png with an empty background.

3) Mrs. Doerrer will send your design through the vinyl cutter

## 4) You will "weed" your design and remove the excess vinyl.





5) Next, place your design vinyl side down on your T-shirt. The shiny plastic side should face up.



6) Place a piece of Teflon or a clean cloth over the design.



7) Heat Press the Design:

- The heat press will be on a temperature of 350 degrees.
- Carefully place your T-shirt on the plate with the design vinyl side down.
- Place Teflon sheet on top.
- Lower the hot plate on top of your design and hold 20-30 seconds.
- Raise the top plate and swivel the arm away from the bottom plate.
- Pull the bottom plate toward you.
- Turn the t-shirt inside out. Reposition on the bottom plate. Place the teflon sheet on top.
- Lower the hot plate on top of your design and hold 20-30 seconds.
- Raise the top plate and swivel the arm away from the bottom plate.
- Pull the bottom plate toward you.
- Let the design cool about a minute.
- Peel away the plastic to reveal your completed T-shirt

8) Turn your T-shirt inside out and iron or heat press the design again. 9) Gently peel away the backing to reveal your design.If any of the design did not stick, repeat steps 6 and 7.
